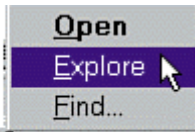




## Exploring in Explorer



Windows Explorer is a utility program that is part of Windows. You can accomplish the same tasks in Explorer as you do in folder windows. The advantage of Explorer is that it is a graphical representation of your computer's filing system. To launch Explorer, either click the Start button, highlight Programs, and then choose Windows Explorer, or right-click the Start button and choose Explore from the context menu. The Explorer window displays with two panes: the folder hierarchy on the left and a folder window on the right.
