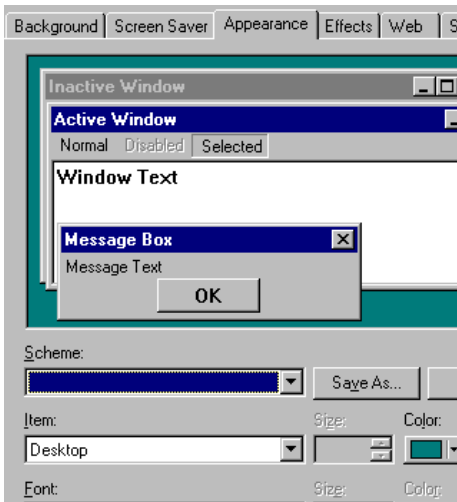
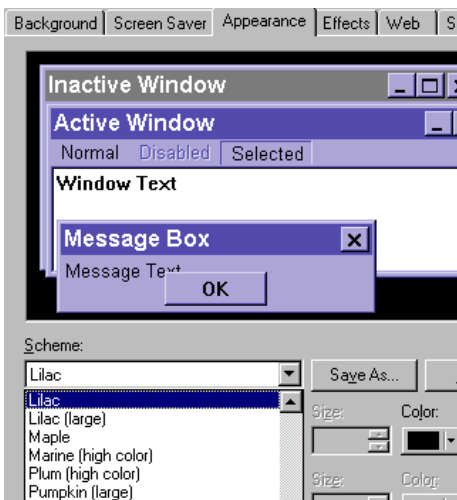




Change Display Settings

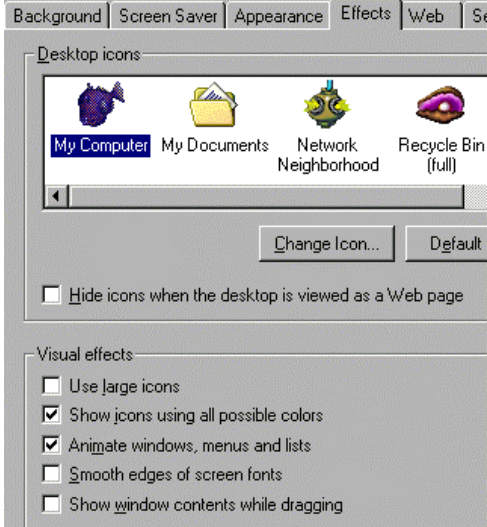


You can change the complete appearance of Windows desktop as well as all its elements right from cursor to menus. Right click on an open area of your monitor and select "Properties." You will see an "Appearance" tab. Click on the "Appearance" tab.



The "Appearance" tab allows you to select the colour, size and font for every conceivable Windows related item from the Desktop, to an Icon, to Active Window, to Inactive Window and the list goes on and on. You can select from a drop-down list of schemes or you can modify any or all of the items yourself and then save the settings as your own personal "scheme". Select any one scheme you like and click "OK" to apply the scheme.





The "Effects" tab (Windows 98 only) allows you to change icons of many of your desktop items and also specify or change many visual effects of your display. Right click on an open area of your monitor and select "Properties." You will see an "Effects" tab, click on it.



You can change icons on many of your desktop items and also specify or change many visual effects. You can select font smoothing and other options also. Please note that displaying large icons and using all possible colours to display icons requires more memory. You may see a slower performance. You can customize the visual settings of your computer in Windows. You can also use "Themes" if you have them installed. You can really "have it your way" when it comes to how your desktop looks and responds.
