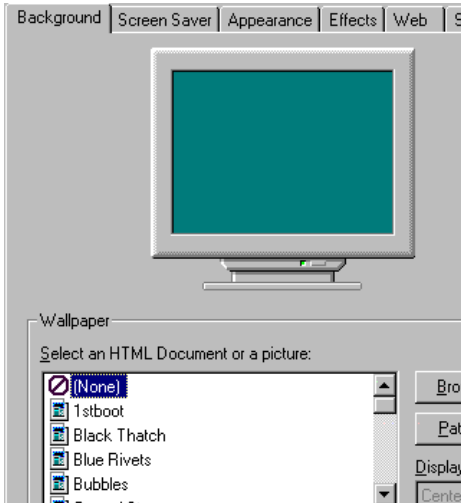
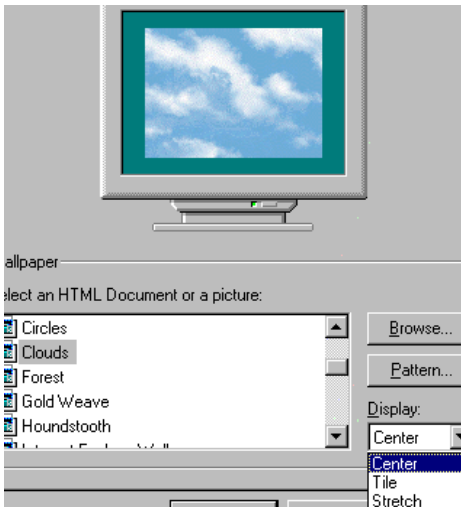




## Setting Background

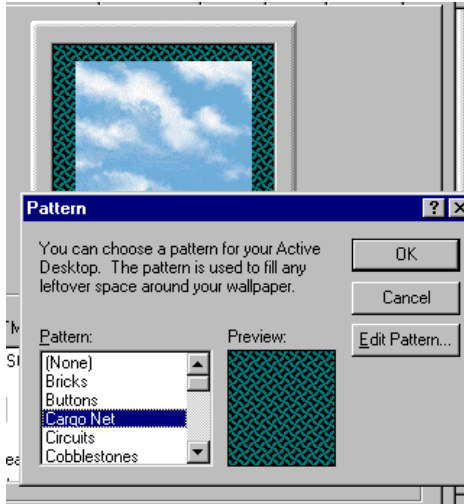


Windows comes with a set of backgrounds. You can also get a variety of interesting images from the Web for use on your display as a background. To change the background, right click on an open area of your monitor and select "Properties." You will see a "Background" tab.

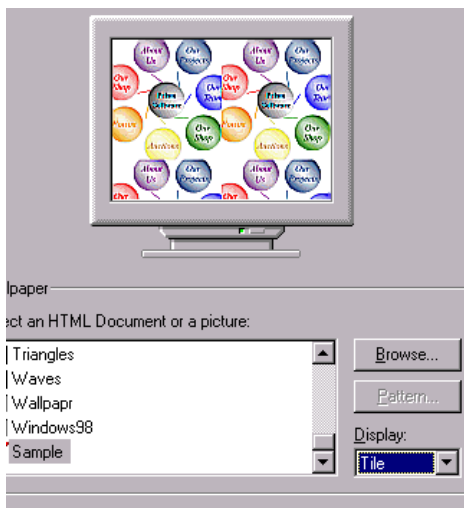


Scroll through the list of "Wallpapers" shown on the lower side. Click on the image to see its effect on your monitor in "Preview" above. You can also choose to "Tile" or "Center" the image on screen. You should use "Tile" for smaller images, so that they fill up the screen.





If you select a smaller image, you can also select a pattern. Click on the "Pattern" button and select a pattern. When you are done, click "OK" and then click "Apply."



You can select any image, photo or logo for your screen background. Click the "Browse" button on the screen. You can navigate and select any BMP, JPG or JIF file in any directory for your wallpaper. If you like something on a Web site, you can right click on any graphic on any Web page that you may be viewing and you will see a menu item to "Set as Wallpaper." Selecting this will make that graphic your desktop wallpaper.
